

Leadership Institute FAQs

Q: What can I expect?

A: You can expect to be in an awesome community that will love you and challenge you to grow! We start the summer with a retreat to bond all the interns together. During the internship, each intern is placed in a ministry area (Student Ministry, Worship, Communication, etc). Throughout each week you will work most your hours in your ministry area. More details about each ministry area can be found on the website. Three times a week interns have classes together. We close out the summer with a Leadership Capstone Experience.

Q: What if I don't live near Geneva?

A: If you do not live locally we do our best to set you up with an awesome host family from Chapelstreet.

Q: Will I make any money?

A: Interns are provided with a stipend of \$2,000 for the summer.

Q: Will I only work in my ministry area?

A: We believe our interns are a vital part of our church community! Outside of your ministry area you will take part in what we call "Cross-Training". This will give you experience in another area of serving in the church.

Q: Can I still go on my family vacation?

A: When accepted into the program each intern is provided with "black out dates" of when it would be really hard to be gone. However, if your vacation does not fall during those dates and you get it approved by the LI team by May 1st, there shouldn't be a problem!

Q: Do I need to have a car?

A: Yes, interns are expected to provide their own transportation and laptop.
