

COVID-19 In-Person Worship Procedures

What you can expect from us

We are excited to regather for indoor worship services. After consideration of the CDC & IDPH recommendations, Chapelstreet will be operating within the guidelines outlined below by doing the following:

- We will implement CDC recommended cleaning standards, and all high-volume areas will be thoroughly sanitized between services.
- We will provide socially distant seating between parties (*at least 6 feet apart*)
- We will provide hand-sanitizing stations throughout the facilities.
- We will NOT offer refreshments (coffee, food, etc.) or access to water fountains.
- We will remove Bibles, hymnals, paper, and pens from our Worship Centers.
- We (*Chapelstreet staff and volunteers*) will wear masks while serving.

While there are inherent risks in gathering, together we can do so as safely as possible in a spirit of unity.

REGISTRATION REQUIRED.

We have established capacity limits at each of our campuses to allow for the required social distancing. Planning for your arrival is vital to providing you with the best experience possible.

KEEP YOUR FAMILY TOGETHER.

Please meet up with your friends and family prior to entering the building. Groups need to enter the Worship Centers together, so please make sure everyone has arrived before you enter.

MAKE THE BEST CHOICE FOR OTHERS.
