



COVID-19 In-Person Worship FAQs

When will campuses open for worship services?

Starting Sunday, October 18th, 9:00 AM and 10:30 AM at our South St (Traditional Worship), Mill Creek, and Keslinger Campuses. We will also continue Saturday, 5:00 PM Outdoor Service at our Mill Creek Campus. All services will be approximately 45 minutes. Seating will begin 15 minutes prior to service times.

Is childcare available?

Yes, *Chapelstreet Kids* (Nursery thru 5th grade) will be operating with limited capacity and preregistration required. Children will be assigned to rooms/spaces in family groups. Masks will be required, and rooms will be routinely sanitized. Additional details available at www.chapelstreet.church/inbuilding

Do I need to register for Sunday worship services?

Yes, you will need to register for our Sunday worship services so we can safely fill the seating capacity according to CDC guidelines. Registration opens up every Monday at 9:00 AM via www.chapelstreet.church/inbuilding

Can I sit with my family/friends?

Yes, please select the number of seats needed when registering. We request you meet up with your friends and family prior to entering the buildings. Groups need to enter the Worship Centers together, so please make sure everyone has arrived before you enter.

Will you be serving refreshments?

Sorry, no. We will not be serving donuts or coffee. Also, there will be no access to water fountains.

Will Chapelstreet staff and volunteers wear masks?

Yes! Our team will be following all recommended safety precautions.

What happens if someone tests positive who attended a service?

The Illinois Department of Public Health handles all contact tracing for COVID cases. We will fully cooperate with the IDPH in this matter.

Will there be singing?

Yes, while wearing masks and maintaining social distancing.
