

COVID PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT

As we re-gather for on-site & off-site ministry events and re-open our facilities, we want to do so safely and with a spirit of unity. We will operate within the guidelines outlined below after consideration of the Illinois Department of Public Health. We request that you follow these practices while attending and participating in this Chapelstreet Church activity. Please pay attention to signage posted around the buildings. Follow CDC and IDPH prevention recommendations. If you are sick, particularly if you have experienced "flu like" symptoms, in the past 14 days, please do not attend any Chapelstreet event. If you have had prolonged exposure to someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 in the past 14 days, do not attend any Chapelstreet event. If you have tested positive for COVID-19, do not attend any Chapelstreet event until you are no longer required to isolate. COVID-19 Symptoms When It's Safe to Be Around Others CDC and IDPH guidelines recommend that people wear masks in public settings and when around people who don't live in your household, especially when other social distancing measures are difficult to maintain. Masks may help prevent people who have COVID-19 from spreading the virus to others. Masks should not be placed on (1) children younger than two years old, (2) anyone with a medical condition in which a mask could cause harm, and (3) anyone who is unable to remove a mask without assistance. With those exceptions, we are strongly recommending everyone wear a mask properly while attending the activity. When attending an event, do your best to remain at least 6 feet apart from others not in your party/household in both indoor and outdoor spaces. Please pay attention to all posted signage. When appropriate staff and volunteers will provide direction on traffic flow within the building or off-site locations. Please consider waiting to interact with fellow attendees until you get outdoors where social distancing will be easier. Social Distancing Guidelines - If at any time you have a confirmed diagnosis of COVID-19 after attending a Chapelstreet event or activity, please go to www.chapelstreet.church/inform to notify our staff. If you make a report, you can choose to remain anonymous. - Given there are a wide variety of perspectives on how to act during this pandemic, please treat one another with love and grace, fostering a spirit of UNITY. For example, if someone is getting too close to you and making you feel uncomfortable, simply ask them in a gentle way for more space. If someone tells you they would like some more space, receive that word without offense. - I acknowledge that participation in the activity that I am signing up for involves risk to the participant (and to the participant's parents or guardians, if the participant is a minor), and may result in various types of injury including, but not limited to, the following: sickness, exposure to infectious/communicable disease, bodily injury, death, emotional injury, personal injury, property damage, and financial damage. In consideration for the opportunity to participate in this activity, the participant (or parent/guardian if the participant is a minor) acknowledges and accepts the risks of injury associated with participation in and transportation to and from the activity. The participant (or parent/guardian) accepts personal financial responsibility for any injury or other loss sustained during the activity or during transportation to and from the activity, as well as for any medical treatment rendered to the participant that is authorized by Chapelstreet Church or its agents, employees, volunteers, or any other representatives (collectively referred to as the "activity sponsor"). Further, the participant (or parent/guardian) releases and promises to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the activity sponsor for any injury arising directly or indirectly out of the described activity or transportation to and from the activity, whether such injury arises out of the negligence of the activity sponsor, the participant, or otherwise. If a dispute over this agreement or any claim for damages arises, the participant (or parent/guardian) agrees to resolve the matter through a mutually acceptable alternative dispute resolution process. If the participant (or parent/guardian) and the activity sponsor cannot agree upon such a process, the dispute will be submitted to a three-member arbitration panel for resolution in accordance with the rules of the American Arbitration Association.

In the event that a student displays symptoms of Covid-19, Chapelstreet staff will isolate student until a parent is able to pick him/her up.
