



Worship Director – North Aurora Campus

General Description:

The Worship Director for the North Aurora is responsible for planning, administering and leading the worship experience at the North Aurora Campus on a weekly basis. This is a 15-hour per week position.

Reports to: Campus Pastor in collaboration with Pastor of Worship Ministries

Key Responsibilities:

- Leading and shepherding worship for weekly services
- Planning the service and creating an order of worship in Planning Center Online one week in advance of each service
- Leading rehearsals, recruiting and scheduling musicians to help lead worship
- Preparing slides accurately in ProPresenter and uploading additional service content prior to the service
- Preparing sheet music for each musician
- Researching new music in collaboration with other worship staff
- Attending worship meetings
- Contribute to and participate in all church worship events as required
- Other responsibilities as assigned

Abilities and Attributes:

- Abiding personal relationship with Jesus Christ
- Adoption of the Chapelstreet Church statement of faith, ministry vision and values, becoming a member at the first opportunity
- At least two years of experience as a worship leader
- Ability to lead with an instrument and to demonstrate and coach others
- Ability to lead vocally and with other worship leaders
- Ability and experience in arranging and writing charts
- A spirit of humility, cooperation and collaboration with other worship and pastoral staff
- Ability to work with ProPresenter, Planning Center Online and other music and media applications

- Strong ability to communicate clearly and in necessary detail, both verbal and written
- Highly relational and very capable of providing effective leadership to paid staff and volunteers
- Ability to enhance positive team environment built on creativity, innovation, communication, collaboration, and continuous improvement
- Degree in worship or music-related field preferred; seminary degree a plus
