General Description

The Director of Worship is a full-time position. The Director will lead worship for our Mill Creek Campus Saturday Night service and the North Aurora Campus Sunday service(s). Working in collaboration with campus pastors and the Pastor of Worship & Creative, the Director will empower worship by planning, rehearsing, and leading worship services on a weekly basis.

Director's Responsibilities

- Plan, rehearse, and lead weekly worship services.
- Leading rehearsals, recruiting, and scheduling musicians to help lead worship
- Shepherd and mentor worship volunteers
- Recruit, train, and schedule staff and volunteers for the weekend worship services
- Create ProPresenter slides and prepare charts and multitrack (if used)
- Contribute to the creative process as a member of the worship staff
- Attending worship meetings
- Contribute to and participate in all church worship events as required
- Other worship-related responsibilities as assigned and in alignment with specific giftedness

Director's Abilities & Attributes

- Abiding personal relationship with Jesus Christ
- Adoption of the Chapelstreet Church statement of faith, ministry vision and values
- Becoming a Chapelstreet member at the first opportunity
- At least two years of experience on a church staff as a worship leader
- Ability to lead vocally and instrumentally
- Ability to play multiple band instruments a plus
- Ability to demonstrate and coach volunteers vocally and instrumentally
- Ability and experience in arranging and writing charts, contributing to our efforts to create original music and empowering others to do so.
- A spirit of humility, cooperation and collaboration with other worship members and pastoral staff
- Ability to work with ProPresenter, Ableton, Planning Center Online and other music and media applications

- Desired but not required is the ability to use technical production equipment including digital audio consoles and lighting
- Strong ability to communicate clearly, both verbal and written
- Highly relational and very capable of providing effective leadership to worship volunteers
- Ability to enhance positive team environment built on creativity, innovation, communication, collaboration, and continuous improvement
- Degree in worship or music-related field preferred
