General Description

The Family Life Coordinator is a part-time position and will provide support to the Campus Pastor and family ministries at the North Aurora Campus, by leading and organizing key programming at the campus level. This position is a vital part of delivering ministry programming that is aligned with Chapelstreet Church's vision to help our children and families experience grace, grow in faith, and make an impact for where they are.

Responsibilities

Working under the leadership of the Campus Pastor and the Director of Chapelstreet Kids, the Coordinator will serve our children and families by designing and executing effective Sunday morning ministry as well as other family ministry events and programs.

The duties include but are not limited to:

- Coordinate and execute all Kids programs on Sunday mornings
- Recruit and coordinate all volunteers, including teachers, providing timely communication to them about program details
- Support the implementation of curriculum that is provided by central ministries
- Ensure volunteers are prepared with the week's lessons and related activities and that the rooms are ready for use
- Maintain meaningful connection and communication with parents about program activities
- Represent the priorities of centralized family ministry in ongoing North Aurora staff meetings
- Participate in Chapelstreet Kid's meetings and events and represent campus specific concerns
- Grow the impact of Chapelstreet North Aurora in our neighborhood through consistent engagement with community partners, schools etc
- Support any other campus need when requested
