### **General Description**

The Associate Director of Worship will collaboratively lead Keslinger Campus worship ministry and provide support for campuses/aspects of Chapelstreet Worship as assigned. This part time position will average 30 hours per week with some variability both over and under this amount of time depending on weekly job requirements.

The Associate Director of Worship should be highly trained and skilled in music, with demonstrated ability in preferably more than one instrument (i.e., piano, guitar, etc.) as well as adept vocal skill/knowledge. The Associate Director of Worship is familiar with AV, sound, and music multimedia programs and equipment. Must also be able to successfully work in a dynamic team environment.

### **Responsibilities**

- Provide leadership, and execution for Keslinger Campus corporate worship experiences as directed by the Pastor of Worship
- Provide worship leadership for 25-30 services per year at the Keslinger Campus to be assigned by the Pastor of Worship
- Provide worship leadership for services at other campuses as assigned
- Able to design and execute weekly and special programming on schedule
- Participate in the ongoing songwriting culture of the church, while exercising unique giftings and talents to the worship culture of the church
- Maintain volunteer schedule in collaboration with Pastor of Worship
- Other duties as assigned

- At least three years ministry experience in worship leadership preferred
- Proficiency in music theory, Nashville Number System, and song arranging
- Ability to recruit and train volunteers to be part of the worship team
