**Traveling:** Chapelstreet Church provides transportation to and from Expeditions Unlimited. The cost of transportation is included in the registration fee.

### Departure and Check In (Keslinger location - 3435 Keslinger Rd, Geneva, IL 60134)

Depart: Check in between 1:00-1:30pm on May 31st. Buses depart at 1:30pm.

Return: June 3rd at approximately 5:00pm. Parents will receive a text message notifying them of the buses ETA using the phone number included upon registration.

**Medical Information / Health:** If a student has a dietary restriction, please note that upon registration. All medication will be gathered during check in. During the camp, students will have opportunities to take their medication with a nurse present.

**Camp Activities:** Students will experience daily worship, teaching, small groups, and free time. Other activities include archery, rock climbing, field games, swimming, boating, and more. Students will bus to Noah's Ark Waterpark in Wisconsin Dells on the last day before heading back home. The only activity that comes at an additional cost is paintball, which can be chosen upon registration for a \$20 fee.

**“Unplugged” Atmosphere:** The Adventure Trip is an UNPLUGGED experience for students where phones are left at home. This helps to ensure students are getting connected and the full benefit of a retreat! Your students will be in the good hands of leaders. **Packing List:** Each student is permitted to bring one piece of luggage plus one bedding item (including pillow). A personal item (backpack) is welcome for students to bring on the buses.
