General Description

The Pastor of Chapelstreet Students is responsible for assessing, developing, and implementing ministry programming for students grades 6 through 12. Responsibilities include establishing ministry vision and values, developing effective ministry strategies and programs, and partnering with other departments to carry out the overall mission of Chapelstreet Church. The Pastor will work to provide cohesive programming across the Next Gen Departments and incorporate parent equipping into ministry programming, believing that parents are the primary disciplers of their students.

Key Responsibilities

As the leader of high school and middle school ministry, the pastor will serve students through teaching from God’s Word, mentoring, equipping, counseling, and discipleship, by designing and executing effective programming (both weekly and special programming such as missions trips, outreach events, and local service projects). In addition, the pastor will provide direct supervision to the Director of Middle School ministries.

Duties will include but are not limited to:

- Developing programs that connect students to Jesus and helping them find their place in His church
- Building cohesion and collaboration between High School and Middle School ministries.
- Maintaining meaningful connections and communication with parents
- Supporting and resourcing parents as the primary disciplers of their children
- Work with other Next Gen staff to create an intentional and cohesive developmental experience for our children and students
- Collaborating with campus pastors to ensure that a student ministry plan is developed and implemented for every campus
- Leading and developing ministry staff, residents, and interns
- Recruiting and developing volunteers
- Managing a budget
- Growing the impact of Chapelstreet Student Ministry at Chapelstreet Church (attendance, baptisms, first-time decisions, etc.), in our community, and beyond

- 3-5 years of experience leading local church high school ministry
- Bible College Master's preferred, Bachelor degree required

- Highly relational and capable of working effectively with ministry leaders and volunteers
