# **Prayer**

#### Read

Matthew 5:8

#### Main Ideas

This week, we examined the sixth of the "Beatitudes"- Jesus' words of blessing to the pure in heart. Jesus' invitation is not just to those who are without sin, but rather, to those who have a singular desire to worship and glorify God.

Jesus promises that those in His Kingdom will see God- in other words, that they will experience the loving presence of the Father in their lives.

### **Discussion Questions**

- 1. In one sentence or less, how would you define what it means to be "pure in heart"? What comes to mind when you think about purity?
- 2. The theologian Soren Kierkegaard once said that "Purity of heart is to will one thing". What do you think he means by that?
- 3. As a group, read Exodus 33:18-23.
  - a. What does this passage teach us about the significance of seeing God?
  - b. Can you think of specific moments where you experienced God's presence in a unique way?
- 4. As a group, read Psalm 119:9-16.
  - a. What does this passage teach us about how we pursue purity?
- 5. In the sermon, we heard purity of heart described not as total sinlessness, but as singleness of mind.
  - a. How would you describe the state of your heart? Pure? Diluted? Defiant? Down?
  - b. What keeps your heart from being pure in your desire for God?
