Come and See: Week 4

## Icebreaker Question

- If you could sit down with any person, past or present, who would it be?

## Prayer

Take a few moments at the beginning and end of your group time to pray for each other and for your discussion in God's Word.

## Read

Luke 24:13-35

## Main Ideas

This week, we finished our Come and See series by examining Jesus' conversation with two of His disciples on the road to Emmaus. Jesus explains how all of Scripture points to Him before revealing His identity. Upon this realization, the disciples share the news that Christ is risen!

## Discussion Questions

1. What expectations did these disciples have of Jesus? What did they get wrong about who Jesus is?
  - a. How does Jesus respond to their confusion and disappointment?
  - b. Can you relate to these two disciples, who had hopes and expectations for Jesus that He did not live up to- at least, not in the way that they wanted Him to?
2. Have you ever looked back and saw God working in your life, even though you didn't realize what He was doing in the moment?
3. As a group, read v. 27.
  - a. What does this teach us about the way in which we should read the Bible? Who does the Bible point towards?
  - b. How does this change the way you think about the Old Testament?
4. As a group, read v 28-29.
  - a. Why do you think Jesus waited for an invitation from these disciples?
  - b. What about this is instructive for us?
5. How do the disciples respond to their encounter with Jesus in v. 33-35?
  - a. Would you describe yourself as more of a spectator or a witness in your faith- or, some combination of both?
