Rebuilding Together: Week 3

### Icebreaker Question

- Do you prefer group projects or working alone?

### Prayer

Take a few moments at the beginning and end of your group time to pray for each other and for your discussion in God's Word.

### Read

Nehemiah 3

### Main Ideas

This week, we continued our *Rebuilding Together* series as the people begin to repair the walls of Jerusalem, and Nehemiah lists all who led the rebuilding efforts. In this, we see the way that God rebuilds brokenness in our lives, in the church, and in the world- through the strength of community, with a posture of humility, and through ordinary acts of faithfulness.

### Discussion Questions

1. As a group, read 1 Cor. 12:12-27.
  - a. Where do you see this example lived out in Nehemiah 3?
2. What does the naming of each person/group teach us about how God views and values our work?
3. This chapter is filled with people serving outside of their training and comfort.
  - a. Have you ever served in a way that made you uncomfortable? How did God use that obedience?
  - b. Is there something you're putting off doing because of the way it might stretch you?
4. In v. 5, we see the one group of people of refused to participate. Why do you think they wouldn't serve?
  - a. Have you ever made an excuse, or let pride get in the way of what God was doing in your midst?
5. What part of the "Chapelstreet wall" might God be calling you to get involved in?
